August 2023 - Return of the Annual Book Sale



The annual used book sale returned following three years of absence during the pandemic years. Held at Jordan Lutheran Church, Orefield, PA, it was a successful summer venture! The air-conditioned multipurpose room and ample parking provided an excellent venue for the sale. The church served as a welcome host for our needs.





In total, 111 volunteers amassed hundreds of hours in preparing, organizing, and selling items which included used books, puzzles, CDs, DVDs, games, and audio books. Puzzles were great sellers this year as well as all genres of books. A \$15 entry fee was charged the first evening of the sale (*FREE* for all *Friends'* members) while the other three days were free entry. The last sale day was bag day, with a filled bag for \$10. We realized a profit of over \$8,000.


